Important Information For Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 users

IMPORTANT INFORMATION


Applicants that utilize Internet Explorer 8 will not be able to get access to the below "JAG Corps Online Application" link. Applicants with Internet Explorer 8 have two options:

(1) Applicants desiring to gain access to the below "JAG Corps Online Application" link using Internet Explorer 8 must download and install Department of Defense root certificates from <https://www.dodpke.com/InstallRoot/>. Applicants can either install "InstallRoot 3.13.msi" (requires Java Runtime) or "InstallRoot 3.13wJRE-6u18.msi" (does not require Java Runtime).

(2) Applicants can use a different browser such as Internet Explorer 7, Firefox, or Safari. Applicants are advised that "Google Chrome" should not be used since it has the same problems as Internet Explorer 8 when using Apple or MACs.

Open the browser.




Trusted Sites


Once the site has been added to the trusted list, click the close button.
