PER CURIAM:

After careful consideration of the record, submitted without assignment of error, we find that the providence inquiry established the appellant's guilt to a period of unauthorized absence beginning on 10 March 2009 vice 9 March 2009. We affirm the findings, except that as to Specification 2 under Charge I we affirm a finding of guilty of an unauthorized absence commencing on 10 March 2009 and terminating on 5 July 2009. There being no dramatic change in the sentencing landscape, we affirm the sentence as approved by the convening authority. Art.
