**OPINION OF THE COURT**

**IN ACCORDANCE WITH RUE 18.2, NMCCA RULES OF PRACTICES AND PROCEDURE, THIS  
OPINION DOES NOT SERVE AS PRECEDENT.**

PER CURIAM:

A military judge sitting as a special court-martial convicted the appellant, pursuant to his pleas, of three specifications of wrongful use of marijuana, in violation of Article 112a, Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 912a. The convening authority (CA) approved the appellant's sentence of confinement for 90 days, reduction to pay grade E-1, forfeiture of \$964.00 pay per month for three months, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the CA suspended all confinement in excess of 30 days for six months, to be remitted without further action unless sooner vacated.

This case was submitted without assignment of error.

In the court-martial order, the appellant is correctly identified in the opening paragraph, with the correct rank and the last four numbers of his social security number. However, a scrivener's error is present in the court-martial order, under the "Approval" section, whereby the appellant is improperly identified by his surname only.<sup>1</sup> No prejudice is alleged and we find none.

The findings and the sentence are affirmed. The supplemental court-martial order shall correctly indicate the appellant's surname.
