PER CURIAM:

This case is before us for a second time. In our initial decision, *United States v. Wood*, No. 200900436, 2010 CCA LEXIS 24, unpublished op. (N.M.Ct.Crim.App. 25 Jan 2010), we disapproved the finding of guilty of rape, affirmed the finding of guilty of an orders violation, and set aside the sentence. We authorized a rehearing on sentence or, alternatively, approval of a sentence of no punishment. By action of 11 March 2010, the CA approved a sentence of no punishment.

No further errors remaining or being raised, we affirm the findings and the approved sentence.
