OPINION OF THE COURT

After careful consideration of the record, submitted without assignment of error, we affirm the findings and sentence as approved by the convening authority. Art. 66(c), Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c). Based on a multiplicity ruling by the military judge following the acceptance of pleas, entered without Government objection, the supplemental court-martial order will reflect findings of guilty for Charge I and its specification, and Charge II, Specifications 2 and 4.
