**OPINION OF THE COURT**

After careful consideration of the record, submitted without assignment of error, we affirm the findings and sentence as approved by the convening authority. Art. 66(c), Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c). We note two harmless errors in the court-martial order. To correct the record, the supplemental court-martial order will reflect that the appellant pled and was found guilty of Specification 2 under Additional Charge II, and that he pled guilty to Additional Charge III and the specification thereunder before the convening authority withdrew that charge and specification prior to the

announcement of findings. See *United States v. Crumpley*, 49 M.J. 538, 539 (N.M.Ct.Crim.App. 1998).
