OPINION OF THE COURT

After careful consideration of the record, submitted without assignment of error, we affirm the findings and sentence as approved by the convening authority. Art. 66(c), Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c). The supplemental court-martial order will reflect that confinement in excess of 90 days was suspended for a period of six months from the date of trial, as required by the pretrial agreement, vice for six months from the date of the convening authority's action as is

stated in the original special court-martial order. See United States v. Cox, 46 C.M.R. 69, 72 (C.M.A. 1972).
