OPINION OF THE COURT

After careful consideration of the record, submitted without assignment of error, we affirm the findings and the sentence as approved by the convening authority. Art. 66(c), Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c). The court-martial order (CMO) reflects that the appellant pleaded and was found guilty of two specifications, described as "commit sexual contact." The record clearly indicates that appellant was convicted of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Article 120(d), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 920(d). The supplemental CMO shall

reflect that as to Specifications 1 and 2 the appellant pled guilty to and was found guilty of "abusive sexual contact."
