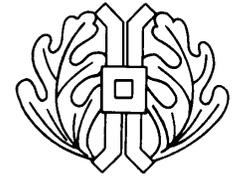

WHO ARE THEY?

The Family Advocacy Program (FAP) is designed to prevent child abuse and spousal abuse, to intervene effectively when incidents do occur, to promote healthy family life, and to improve readiness and retention.

CAN THEY REALLY HELP?

Experience shows that the FAP can be tremendously effective in serving families and supporting the Navy mission.

HOW DOES THE PROCESS WORK?

Cases are referred to the FAP from various sources; Family Service Center, Chaplains, Commands, Medical, Base Security, etc. FAP then contacts both the Command and the service member to arrange an interview with the family and a social worker. A review committee investigates the case. Recommendations from the review committee are sent to the Command. Cases are then monitored for up to one year.
