*Once you have mailed your packet to Lincoln, NE, send your Request for Overseas Processing letter:*

- **Request for Overseas Processing letter:** if you are an active duty member of the U.S. Armed Forces currently stationed abroad, or you will be deployed overseas in the next few months, and would like to be processed for naturalization overseas, you can do so by completing and submitting this form to the appropriate USCIS overseas office. Fill in, scan and email this letter immediately after mailing your N-400 packet to Nebraska. A sample of this letter attached to this packet. The "Date Packet Mailed to NSC" is the date you sent your package to the Nebraska Service Center.

- **USCIS Military Helpline:** USCIS has established a **toll-free military help line, 1-877-CIS-4MIL (1-877-247-4645)**, exclusively for members of the military and their families. USCIS customer service specialists are available to answer calls Mon-Fri from 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. (CST), excluding federal holidays. Members of the U.S. armed forces and their families stationed in the United States or overseas may access the help line using the toll-free number through their base telephone operator or using the Defense Switched Network (DSN).

GERMANY: Requests for processing in Germany should be submitted by E-mail to USCIS Frankfurt at: USCIS.Frankfurt@dhs.gov
AFGHANISTAN- Requests for processing in Afghanistan should be submitted by E-mail to USCIS Bangkok at: USCIS.Afghanistan@dhs.gov
