SUBJECT: Cancellation of JAGINST 1212.1C

- Request approval of the cancellation of JAGINST 1212.1C, JAG Corps Targeted Augmentation Program.
- Subject instruction was promulgated in 2004. The Targeted Augmentation Program (TAP) identified judge advocates with career potential and allowed them to augment from the Naval Reserve (Active) to the Regular Navy through the transfer/redesignation process. TAP has been superseded by the Career Status Board process promulgated in JAGINST 1212.2A (JAG Corps Career Status Board).
- JAGINST 1212.2A (JAG Corps Career Status Board (CSB)) provides for the selection of judge advocates with career potential for continued service beyond their initial four year active duty service obligation. Officers selected by the CSB are also eligible to apply for Judge Advocate Continuation Pay (JACP) in return for additional obligated service. Officers who are not selected through CSB, or who elect not to apply for JACP, may be involuntarily separated through the Probationary Officer Continuation Review Board process.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve cancellation of JAGINST 1212.1C by initialing as appropriate.
