SUBJECT: Cancellation of COMNAVLEGSVCCOMINST 5530.1

- Request approval of the cancellation of COMNAVLEGSVCCOMINST 5530.1, PHYSICAL SECURITY AND LOSS PREVENTION.
- Subject instruction was promulgated in 2004. 1999 program and instruction on which subject instruction was based has been renamed and superseded by OPNAVINST 5530.14E, Department of the Navy's Physical Security and Law Enforcement Requirements.
- OPNAVINST 5530.14E provides that Navy Regions and Installation Commanding Officers (ICOs) establish and provide the Navy's security program, to include Anti-Terrorism (AT), Physical Security (PS), and Law Enforcement (LE).
- Tenant COs and OICs are instructed by OPNAVINST 5530.14E to implement and comply with the installation's security program, as directed by the ICO.
- Specifically, "The COs of tenant activities shall retain only those internal security functions intrinsic to their organizations and missions, which include PS of facilities, personnel security, information security, industrial security, and information assurance," per Paragraph 0101 of Enclosure 1 of the instruction.
- OPNAVINST 5530.14E does not require tenant organizations to provide or appoint security officers, nor does it require Echelon II commands to do so.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve cancellation of COMNAVLEGSVCCOMINST 5530.1. by initialing as appropriate:
