ARCHIPELAGIC, STRAIGHT BASELINES, & HISTORIC CLAIMS	Dec 1992	<a href="#">Law No. 60/IV/92</a>		Promulgates geographical coordinates for archipelagic baselines.  In 1977, Cabo Verde proclaimed excessive baselines which were not recognized by the U.S. The U.S. protested the 1977 claims in 1980 and 1989 and conducted an operational assertion in FY 1989. This 1992 law revokes the 1977 decree, and modifies its archipelagic baselines to accord with the LOS Convention.
