

OBTAINING A NAVY JAG CORPS INTERVIEW

LEP and IPP applicants must schedule an interview with two Navy JAG Corps officers (also known as a “Structured Interview”) prior to submitting their application. Informational and command interviews do not satisfy this requirement. Once completed, the interview is valid for three years. Applicants may not complete more than one interview within a three-year period.

To schedule an interview, send an e-mail to the regional office closest to your current duty station, using the list provided below. Please identify yourself as a LEP or IPP applicant in the message. If you have not received a response within five business days, or if you have questions about the application process, contact the JAG Corps Accessions Office directly at navyaccessions@navy.mil.
