ORDER

Postponing Oral Argument

Oral argument is currently scheduled for 25 March 2020 at 1000. On 24 March 2020, the Government filed Appellee's Motion for Leave to File and Appellee's Motion to Reschedule Oral Argument. The Government's motion is premised on Appellee's counsel experiencing a symptom consistent with novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).¹ Appellant opposes the motion, suggesting other Government counsel can represent Appellee or, in the alternative, Government's counsel could appear via remote telephonic means.
