Subj: NAVY WORKING UNIFORM POLICY

- 1. Purpose.** This notice updates the Navy Working Uniform (NWU) wear policy for personnel assigned to the Office of the Judge Advocate General (OJAG) or Naval Legal Service Command (NLSC) Headquarters in the National Capitol Region.
- 2. Cancellation.** This notice cancels 06 NOTICE 1020 dated March 16, 2018.
- 3. Background.** Reference (a) announced the phased roll-out plan for the NWU Type III (green digital camouflage) which will replace the NWU Type I (blue digital camouflage) as the daily working uniform beginning 1 October 2019. Until that time, both the NWU Type I or NWU Type III may be worn to work and for off-base commuting stops. Reference (a) specifically excludes the Pentagon, the National Mall, Capitol Hill and adjoining office buildings, the White House, State Department, and all monuments and memorials from NWU wear (Type I or Type III). Reference (b) establishes the rules for traveling and commuting while in uniform. Reference (c), as modified by reference (d), prescribes the uniform of the day for Marines in the National Capitol Region.
- 4. Policy.** NWUs Type I and Type III are authorized uniforms and may be worn consistent with references (a) and (b) Monday through Thursday. The NWU Type I will be authorized through 30 September 2019, after which, only NWU Type III will be authorized for wear. The Pentagon remains an area excluded by reference (a) from NWU wear. OJAG/NLSC HQ Navy personnel stationed at the Washington Navy Yard may wear NWU Type I with black boots or NWU Type III with black, desert, or coyote boots while working outside the zones established by reference (a). NWU Type IIIs may be worn with the official OJAG/NLSC headquarters command ball cap as permitted by reference (a). Enclosure (1) provides a visual representation of the approved design. All rules established in reference (b) remain in effect, and personnel whose regular duties require travel within the zones established in reference (a) must maintain

appropriate uniforms necessary for those locations. Marines assigned to OJAG/NLSC HQ will continue to follow references (c) and (d). NWUs are not authorized in any location on Fridays. Navy personnel will wear the Service Uniform (E-6 and below) or Service Khaki (E-7 and above) on Fridays in alignment with Marine Corps uniform policies.

5. **Records Management.** Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.
