

**The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial convened within the United States Navy in March 2019. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.**

## **Naval District Washington**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, D.C., an E-8 was tried for two specifications of sexual assault of a child, two specifications of sexual assault, and aggravated assault by strangulation. On 6 March 2019, members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, D.C., a midshipman was tried for use of a controlled substance. On 20 March 2019, members returned a verdict of not guilty.

### **Special Courts-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Washington, D.C., YN1 Thomas Jenkins, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to sexual harassment and two specifications of knowingly photographing the private area of another person without that person's consent. On 14 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-3, and confinement for 8 months. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

## **Navy Region Mid-Atlantic**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, PSC Frantz Beauge, USN, was tried for three specifications of sexual abuse of a child. On 1 March 2019, members returned a verdict of guilty to two specifications of sexual abuse of a child and sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 1 year.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ABHAN Jonathon E. A. Carriker, USN, was tried for sexual assault. On 13 March 2019, members returned a verdict of guilty and sentenced him to a Dishonorable Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 12 months.

### **Special Courts-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-6 was tried for sexual harassment, aggravated sexual contact, and two specifications of abusive sexual contact. On 1 March 2019, members returned a verdict of not guilty.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-8 was tried for wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 26 March 2019, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.

## **Navy Region Southeast**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- None.

### **Special Courts-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, SH2 Victor J. Gorea Jr., USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to failure to obey a military protective order and assault consummated by battery. On 6 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-3, confinement for 3 months, and forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 3 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 45 days is to be suspended. The suspended confinement may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-5 was tried for assault consummated by battery. On 14 March 2019, members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, FR Demaje O. Williamsliburd, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to willful dereliction of duty, communicating a threat, and larceny of military property. On 15 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 135 days. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

## **Navy Region Northwest**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, CDR Warren K. Frey, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of disobeying a lawful order, four specifications of breaking restriction, and being drunk on duty. On 1 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a reprimand and confinement for 120 days. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 30 days is to be suspended. The suspended confinement may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's board of inquiry.

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, AT1 Jak Lopezlarracuente, USN, was tried for fraternization, sexual assault, adultery, and providing a false official statement. On 13 March 2019, members returned a verdict of guilty to providing a false official statement and sentenced him to a reprimand and forfeiture of \$300 pay per month for 3 months.

### **Special Courts-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Everett, Washington, HT2 Cory J. Farnum, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to four specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 20 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-2 and confinement for 89 days. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 45 days is to be suspended. The suspended confinement may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, EMN2 John A. Torris, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of wrongful use, possession, distribution, and introduction onto a naval base of a controlled substance. On 21 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 4 months. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Everett, Washington, DC3 Andrew W. Guiette, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to operating a vehicle while drunk, drunk and disorderly conduct, and assault consummated by a battery. On 22 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 60 days. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

## **Navy Region Southwest**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, EMFR Kondali A. Kangha, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of attempted larceny and four specifications of larceny. On 15 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a Bad Conduct Discharge and confinement for 24 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 6 months is to be disapproved.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AMC Donismael G. Faustino, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of sexual abuse of a child. On 27 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a Dishonorable Discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for four years. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

## **Special Courts-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, STGSN Annie N. Lunsford, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to eleven specifications of absence without leave, possession of a controlled substance, four specifications of use of a controlled substance, false official statement, and obstruction of justice. On 7 March 2019, the military judge sentenced her to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 10 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement all confinement in excess of 120 days is to be suspended. The suspended confinement may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, ET2 Chason M. Lenz, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to larceny. On 8 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to forfeit \$250 pay per month for 3 months and a reduction in rank to paygrade E-4. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, GMSA Khali K. Lane, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to dereliction of duty. On 8 March 2019, the military judge sentenced her to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 30 days. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement is to be disapproved. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AMAN Rordanny Valdes, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery and obstruction of justice. On 22 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to forfeit \$1,200 pay per month for 1 month, reduction in rank to paygrade E-2, and confinement for 30 days. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

## **Navy Region Hawaii**

## **Navy Region Japan**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Okinawa, Japan, OS2 Allen J. Jewell, USN, was tried for attempted rape of a child, two specifications of attempted sexual abuse of a child, and indecent language. On 1 March 2019, members returned a verdict of guilty to all charges and specifications and sentenced him to a Dishonorable Discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 5 years.
- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, an E-4 was tried for sexual assault and abusive sexual contact. On 6 March 2019, a panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, HM1 Diego F. Davilanarvaez, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to signing a false document, larceny of military property, and two specifications of patronizing a prostitute. On 22 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a Dishonorable Discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 3 years. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 18 months is to be suspended. The suspended confinement may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.
- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, an E-5 was tried for rape and sexual assault. On 28 March 2019, members returned a verdict of not guilty.

### **Special Courts-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, HN Joshua D. Eoff, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery. On 13 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 127 days. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

## **Navy Region Europe, Africa, Southwest Asia**

### **General Courts-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, LSC Calvin Halfacre, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of patronizing a prostitute. On 14 March 2019, the military judge sentenced him to a Dishonorable Discharge and confinement for 30 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, a Bad Conduct Discharge is to be approved.
- At a General Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, QM3 Kenneth Olaya, USN, was tried for attempted child sex trafficking, attempted enticement of child prostitution, attempted illicit sexual conduct in a foreign place, patronizing prostitutes, and attempted sexual assault of a child. On 22 March 2019, members returned a verdict of guilty to attempted child sex trafficking, patronizing prostitutes, and attempted sexual assault of a child, and

sentenced him to a Dishonorable Discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 15 months.
